Best Practice 1: Clean Campus Green Campus

Initiation: Recognizing the college's natural setting, the Nature Club initiated efforts in 2023-24 to maintain a clean and green campus through gardening and planting.

Objectives: Promote cleanliness, raise pollution awareness, create a tobacco, automobile, and plastic-free zone, and improve waste disposal.

Practice: The Nature Club led a campaign to raise awareness among students and staff, organizing clean-up drives, planting activities, and awareness programs.

Evidence of Success: The campus is neat and clean, dustbins and waste pits are available, and it is a tobacco, automobile, and pollution-free zone.

Challenges and Resources: Funding was a challenge. Resources needed included college funds, a functional plan, monitoring mechanisms, and human resources.

Best Practice 2: Learn the Skills Initiative

Initiation: In response to NEP 2020, the college initiated a "Learn the Skills" program in 2023-24 to emphasize skill development with available resources.

Objectives: Promote skill learning, encourage skill-based careers, foster creative writing and life skills (yoga, tailoring, local language), and activate the Publication and Research Cells.

Practice: The college consulted relevant committees and student representatives to raise awareness. Activities included publishing the college magazine, holding literary and quiz competitions, publishing departmental wall magazines, observing International Yoga Day, and starting certificate courses in Yoga, Tailoring, and Rajbanshi Language.

Evidence of Success: The annual magazine was published, students actively participated in competitions, and certificate courses were launched.

Challenges and Resources: Funding was a major challenge. Resources required included college funds and a functional plan for activities and monitoring.

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
